We acknowledge receipt of the request to modify the definition of start for all Cape 31 Class one design racing up to the end of 31 December 2020, to properly experiment and evaluate development of, and report back on the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020 [RRS], for input on and development of future editions of the RRS.”

The definition will read: “A boat starts when, having been entirely on the pre-start side of the starting line at or after her starting signal, and having complied with rule 30.1 if it applies, any part of her hull crosses the starting line in the direction of the first mark.”
